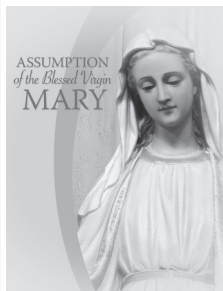

**PASTOR'S COLUMN:**

**FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**



On the 15th of August we celebrate the great feast of our heavenly Mother Mary, that she assumed into heaven, body and soul according to the will of God. It is important that we reflect on her life and pray to her for our needs.

Mary's name is mostly mentioned at the beginning of the Gospel: annunciation, visitation, birth of Christ, flight to Egypt, presentation in the temple, and marriage at Cana. Later on, her name is rarely mentioned. Once during the public ministry of Jesus, then standing under the cross and at the Pentecost. As Jesus "grows" in the stature, Mary seems to step back to the background. That is typical of mothers. A mother offers her time, energy, her whole self, for the children. Their growth is her concern. As they grow in importance and attain maturity, the importance of the mother gets eclipsed. The same tendency we see also in the Bible. Jesus should be the center of the scripture, he must grow.

Mary went the way of self-giving. She oriented herself to the son and his word. She would tell us today "do whatever he tells you" (Jn: 2-5). That would mean that the Gospel of Christ must be the center of our life, his word must regulate our life and live within us bearing abundant fruits.

"Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. Let it be done unto me according to your word". These words of Mary express not only her faith in God's word but also her obedience, readiness to co-operate with God's salvific plan. Mary accepted her vocation to be the mystery of the incarnation: "The word became flesh and dwelt among us". (Jn. 1:4) And thus through Mary's obedience she "became the cause of salvation for herself and for the whole human race".

Today's feast reminds us that Mary's obedience was amply rewarded. She said 'yes' to God and God made her great and raised her to eternal glory with body and soul.

**(This year the feast of our Heavenly Mother Mary is on Saturday, August 15. It is not a Holy Day of Obligation in our Archdiocese and other Dioceses of our Nation, but you are encouraged to pray and honor our heavenly mother Mary on her feast day of the Assumption.)**

**PreK Faith Formation (ages 4/5):** Catechists who would be willing to lead a group of children ages 4-5 during a Sunday morning Mass. You might consider teaming with someone and alternate the Sundays you are teaching. The curriculum is laid out for you and support is provided.

**Grade 1-8 Faith Formation:** Two more catechists to lead a group of children/youth. Grades 1-8 meet on Wednesday evenings from 6:30-7:45 pm. Catechists "echo the Word of God" by sharing the stories of our faith with young people. The curriculum is laid out for you and support is provided throughout the year.

**Children's Liturgy of the Word:** at least 2 more leaders for the 8:45 am Mass and 2 more people for the 10:30 am Mass. Catechists for CLW share the Sunday readings with children in grades K-4 at their own level, and help them reflect on its meaning in their lives. The time commitment is about one Sunday a month.
