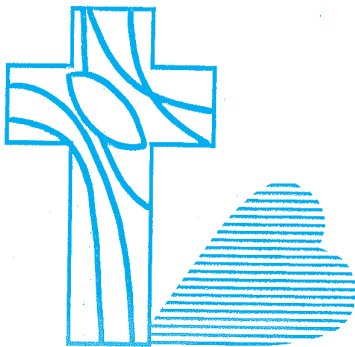

WE CARE CAMPAIGN

On the weekend of March 6 & 7, St. Pascal's parish will gather the loose change and bills from the collection and donate it to the Social Caring Committee's *We Care Campaign*. The three options chosen by the committee for its winter project are:

Option 1: Amazon Relief

Amazon Relief is an organization that brings aid to those living along the Amazon River in Brazil. Many living in this area suffer from: a lack of education, great hunger and leprosy. This organization funds elementary and vocational schools, adult education classes and soup kitchens and provides medicine and mobility carts to lepers. No administrative costs are taken out of the donated monies.

Option 2: LifeCare Center East

The LifeCare Center East (LCCE) is a pro-life, pregnancy help center for women and their babies on St. Paul's eastside. The LCCE offers women pregnancy tests, sonograms, medical and financial assistance, counseling and education in positive life options and provides clothing and nutritional assistance as well. This is a ministry that offers hope and practical assistance to women facing an unplanned pregnancy.

Option 3: San Lucas Toliman Mission in Guatemala

Money donated to this option will be given to Fr. Greg Schaffer, the pastor of the San Lucas Toliman Mission in Guatemala, to continue supporting his efforts in helping the families of this area.

We encourage you to consider making a personal contribution as well, using the envelope provided in the packet of envelopes sent by the parish every other month. If you have a preference, please indicate this by marking the appropriate option on the envelope. If you would like to contribute to more than one of these programs, mark the appropriate options and your contributions will be distributed as requested. Any unmarked contributions will be divided equally among the three options. Thank you for your generosity.
