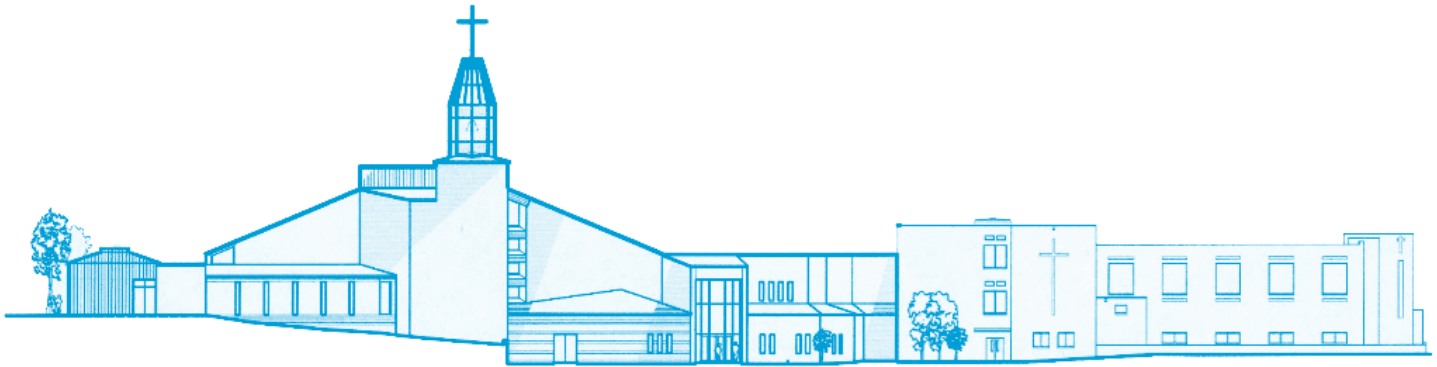

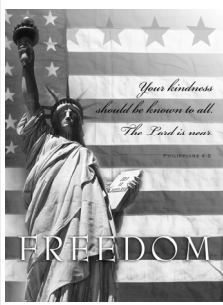

**DEEPENING OUR UNDERSTANDING**

Today we celebrate the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time and it is the 4th of July. The Song of Sending Forth, The Battle Hymn of the Republic, used today is often seen more as a patriotic hymn than a religious hymn. But its text heralds more than national victory over enemies (in this case the Union army over the Confederacy).

On a deeper, eschatological level the text celebrates the ultimate victory of the kingdom of God over all opposing forces. The fourth verse in particular, lays down the challenge of discipleship: that we give our lives that this kingdom come. It is not a battle cry for national victory in war but a testimony that the kingdom of God will triumph no matter what forces vie against it.

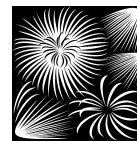
