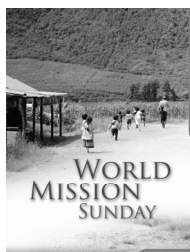

MISSION APPEAL SUNDAY

The Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis has a long history of an outstanding custom of generosity to the missions. Our parishes have responded willingly to both the world Mission collection in October and the Missionary Cooperation Plan which normally takes place each summer. We have also had great tradition of graciousness and hospitality to visiting missionaries.

Under the Missionary Cooperation Plan each pastor is asked to accept one specific missionary to make an appeal for his or her own mission. This weekend, *The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette* will preach the annual parish mission appeal in our parish. Fr. Peter Kohler, MS, is making an appeal for his religious Order. This is certainly a wonderful opportunity for us to know the work of these Missionaries in the vineyard of the Lord. And also make us aware of our own mission entrusted to us on the day we were baptized and received into the church.

Fr. Jack Nuelle, MS, the Executive Director of his above mentioned religious order has sent a brief paragraph to read about their missionary work. Please read:

“Having brought the fullness of Life to our world when He rose from the dead, Jesus sent his disciples to share this life with all of creation. *“They went forth and preached everywhere”* (Mk 16:20). The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette minister to people of every race, language, culture and way of life – beginning at the La Salette Shrine in France where our Blessed Mother appeared in 1846. Her final words, *“Well, my children, you will make this known to all my people,”* echo Jesus’ Gospel mandate. It is little wonder that the La Salette Congregation has always been mission orientated. When called upon by the Vatican to preach the Gospel in foreign lands, they eagerly responded. This spirit brought them to mission in 27 countries, especially among the poor in Angola, Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, India, Madagascar, Myanmar and the Philippines. With your cooperation, the Missionaries of La Salette can continue to provide spiritual and financial assistance to these mission countries as they bring God’s reconciling message to the poor.”

Let us be generous towards the work of these missionaries through our prayers and contributions.

DEEPENING OUR UNDERSTANDING

Next Sunday, July 4, is the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Song of Sending Forth, The Battle Hymn of the Republic, is often seen more as a patriotic hymn than a religious hymn. But its text heralds more than national victory over enemies (in this case the Union army over the Confederacy).

On a deeper, eschatological level the text celebrates the ultimate victory of the kingdom of God over all opposing forces. The fourth verse in particular, lays down the challenge of discipleship: that we give our lives that this kingdom come. It is not a battle cry for national victory in war but a testimony that the kingdom of God will triumph no matter what forces vie against it.
